# STOCKPORT TOWN CENTRE: PROPOSED MANAGED SITES APPROVAL AND CONSULTATION TIMELINE

The Licensing, Environment and Safety Committee (LEAS)	21/06/2017	LEAS must first pass a resolution to give notice of the intention to change the current designation of these areas to Consent Streets for the purpose of street trading. A positive resolution will activate a series of statutory notifications (see below)
Initial Notices	W/C 26/06/2017	Once the council has agreed to resolve to give notice, the proposals must be advertised and copies of the notice served on the police and highway authority (see above). Objections have to be submitted within 28 days of the notice being advertised.
Central Stockport Area Committee	13/07/2017	For Comments
Highways and Planning Sub Committee	27/07/2017	For Comments
The Licensing, Environment and Safety Committee (LEAS)	06/09/2017	Once the statutory notification period has elapsed a further report must be submitted to LEAS to consider the results of any comments or objections received as a result of the committee consultation and public notices and decide on whether to approve the establishment of the new Consent Streets. If the committee decides to approve the proposed changes to the current designation of these areas to Consent Streets, follow up notices will be activated.
Follow-up notices	W/C 11/09/2017	If a resolution to establish the proposed Consent Streets is agreed the resolution must be advertised for two consecutive weeks before the new status comes into effect.
