1. INTRODUCTION AND PURPOSE OF REPORT

- 1.1 To seek approval, to supply and install a new 'street name plate' which is clearer to locate the properties, in order that the postal services can deliver to the correct addresses.

2. INFORMATION

- 2.1 A request has been made by the local councillor to look at installing a new 'street name plate' for Lyncombe Close, to show numbering guidance of the properties, as the road splits.
- 2.2 The improvements to the sign will aid the postal services on a daily basis, in delivering post and parcels to the correct address. However, if there was a requirement by the residents for any of the emergency services, it would help in the response time in reaching their destination.
- 2.3 The signage proposals have been drawn up and approved in principal and can be seen on **Drawing Nos NM36-6155-01 and 02.**
