Report of the Corporate Director for Place Management & Regeneration

1. INTRODUCTION AND PURPOSE OF REPORT

1.1 To seek approval to implement a Traffic Regulation Order on Thomas St, Hillgate.

2. INFORMATION

- 2.1 The Network Management section received a request through the Ward Councillor responsible for Traffic issues, to investigate the difficulties caused by parked vehicles adjacent to the premises of Westbrook House on Thomas Street.
- 2.2 Investigations confirmed that parking at this location did in fact create difficulties for short term disabled visitors to the premises as available spaces were taken up by office workers parking for the full working day.
- 2.3 Therefore, having discussed a way forward with the occupiers of Westbrook House, it was agreed that waiting restrictions be proposed across their frontage. This would allow their visitors who are mainly blue badge holders to park for a limited time whilst attending appointments at Westbrook House.
- 2.4 Traffic Services consulted with the businesses concerned with a proposal based on the attached plan, drawing number <u>NM8/4473/02.</u> Note that the main body of the proposal is on unadopted highway.
- 2.5 Six consultation letters were delivered to the relevant businesses which resulted in 2 (33%) responses.

Both (100%) were in favour of the proposal.

3. FUNDING

3.1 The estimated cost is:

To be funded by the Strategic Highway budget as the location is in the Town Centre.
