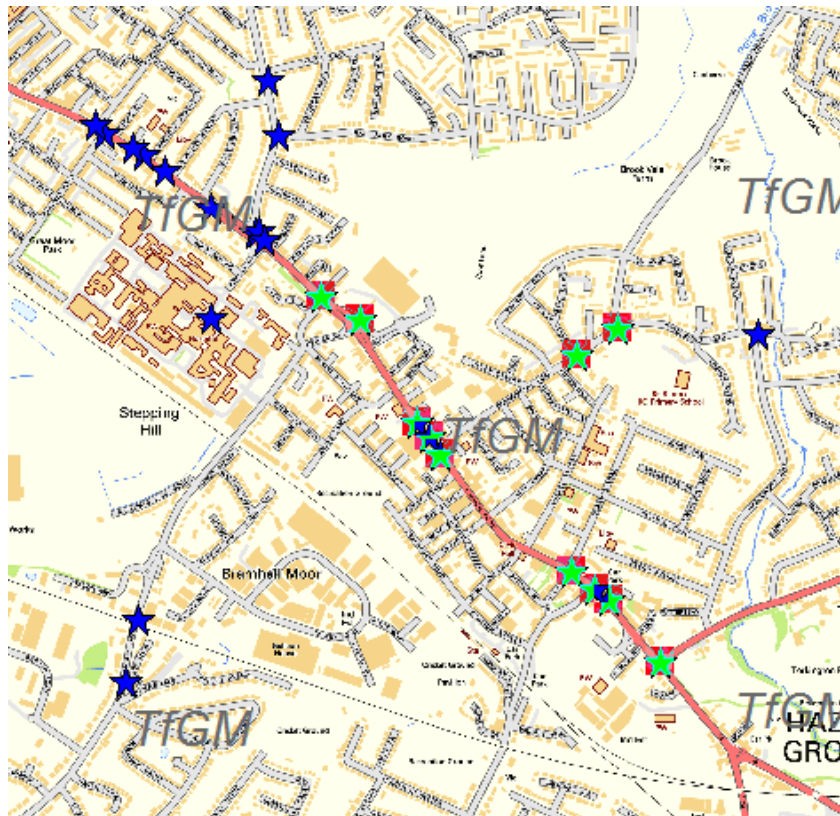


Accident stats 01/07/2015 – 30/06/2018 Commercial Road and A6 London Road, Hazel Grove



A review of the latest three years of traffic accident data (01/07/2015 – 30/06/2018) shows there have been 16 incidents over the specified junctions, resulting in 15 slight injuries, 4 serious injuries and 1 fatality.

7 of these incidents involved pedestrians, resulting in 5 slight and 3 serious injuries (all to pedestrians). Details of these incidents are as follows:

- Junction of London Rd & Sainsbury's Access Road – vehicle travelling SE on London Road turns left into Sainsbury's Access Road & collides with pedestrian west bound on crossing. The causation factors include wet weather and the pedestrian failing to look, this incident resulted in a slight injury to the pedestrian.
- London Rd, 15 metres South East of Angel St – pedestrian attempts to cross London Road South East bound and steps into the path of a vehicle travelling north west down London Road, collision occurs resulting in a slight injury to pedestrian
- London Road 30 metres North West of Commercial Road – vehicle is travelling NW down London Road and hits parked car and pedestrian resulting in a serious injury to the pedestrian, the causation factor has not been determined.
- London Road at junction with Chester Road – two pedestrians cross the junction on Chester Road East Bound when they are hit by a vehicle travelling north west down London Road, driver fails to see pedestrian crossing. This results on one serious and one slight injury.
- London Road at Junction with Angel Street – vehicle travelling south east down London Road collides with pedestrian crossing the carriageway, resulting in a slight injury to the pedestrian. The causation factor determines is driver failing to see the pedestrian.
- London Road at junction with Commercial Road – vehicle is travelling north west on London Road in lane 1 of 2, there is stationary traffic in lane 2. Pedestrian enters carriageway from

drivers near side to cross over and collides with vehicle. The causation factor has been determined to be pedestrian failing to look. This has resulted in a serious injury to pedestrian (child)

- London Road at junction with Commercial Road – vehicle travels North West down London Road, goes through a red light at the junction with Commercial road and collides with pedestrian, resulting in a slight injury to the pedestrian.

There have been three incidents involving motor cyclists, these have resulted in a slight injury, a serious injury and a fatality (all injuries to the motor cyclist drivers). The details of these incidents are:

- Commercial Road at junction with Butley Street – Vehicle one travels north east along Commercial Road, vehicle two (motorcyclist) travelling south east down Butley Street turns left onto Commercial Road and collides with vehicle one causing fatal injuries to motorcyclist driver. The causation factors of the incident are speeding and loss of control from the motorcyclist.
- Bosden Fold Road at junction with Bean Leach Road – motorcyclist travelling west down Bosden Fold planning to turn right into Bean Leach Road collides with vehicle 1 travelling south along Bean Leach Road. The causation factor has been determined as the driver of vehicle 1 failing to look and the incident resulted in a serious injury to the motorcyclist driver.
- London Road 5 metres south of Spring Vale – vehicle one travelling south east down London Road makes a u turn, colliding with a motorcyclist travelling south east down London Road, resulting in a slight injury to the motorcyclist driver.

The other seven incidents resulted in injuries to drivers and passengers. 2 of these incidents involved vehicles turning right and colliding with vehicles travelling opposite:

- London Road at junction with Torkington Road – vehicle one travels north west down London Road, it turns right into the path of vehicle 2 travelling opposite and collision occurs resulting in a light injury the driver on vehicle 2.
- London Road at Junction With Roseberry Street – Vehicle one traveling south west down Roseberry Street turns right into London Road into the path of vehicle 2 and collision occurs, leading to a slight injury to the drivers of both vehicle 1 and 2.

There has been a collision where a driver has driven into street furniture causing one slight injury

- Commercial Road at junction with Short Street – Vehicle 1 turns into Commercial Road travelling North East, it then loses control and collides with postbus at junction with Short Street, resulting in one slight injury to the driver

There have been three collisions as a result of a drivers failing to give way properly, resulting in 5 slight injuries.

- London Road at junction with Chapel Street – Vehicle 1 at the give way of Chapel Street, drives after being waved on by stationary vehicle, and pulls out into the path of vehicle 2 where collision occurs, resulting in a slight injury to the driver of vehicle 1.

- London Road, outside number 210, at junction with Grundey Street – Vehicle 1 travelling north east down Grundey street, emerging into the carriageway in front of stationary vehicle which had given way. Vehicle 2 is travelling south east down London Road, as V2 passes it collides with V1, resulting in a slight injury to the drivers of both vehicles 1 and 2.
- London Road at junction with Grundey Street – Vehicle 1 travels north east down Grundey Street turning right onto London Road, vehicle in lane 1 flashes vehicle 1 to go, vehicle 1 proceeds and collides with vehicle 2 travelling north west down London road in lane 2. This resulted in a slight injury to the driver and passenger of vehicle 2.
