

Traffic Management Plan

Event: Plant Fayre

Date and time: Sunday April 7 2019, 11am – 4pm

Venue: Walled Garden, Bramhall Park

Outline of Event: Outdoor plant fayre.

Managing Visitor Numbers:

- This is an established event in Bramhall Park and has been running for 8 years
- This is a walk-up event and attracts a significant proportion of local people. They are likely to either arrive on foot or be dropped off.
- We have staged similar events before in the same area. These were well managed and no issues arose or concerns raised with regard to parking.
- We will encourage visitors to not bring their cars. We will also communicate information about walking routes and public transport options.
- Both of the on-site car parks will be used. Capacity for the top car park and lower car park is 56 plus 5 accessible bays. The designated coach bays will not be in use and will provide 12 additional spaces. Parking capacity therefore is 68 spaces (plus 5 accessible bays). We estimate a maximum of 125 cars requiring parking at the event.

Use of the Archery Lawn:

- We have requested the use of the Archery Lawn for the parking of cars for stallholders, staff and the public (priority will be given to Blue Badge holders). This will be marshalled by experienced Stockport Council staff. We will follow greenspace guidelines with regard to public safety around the children's play area. Staff will be in high vis jackets and will be in radio communication with staff in the Hall and Park.
- As has been previously agreed we will limit the number of requests to use the Archery Lawn to a maximum of 6 per year.
- We will only request to use the Archery Lawn between the months of April – September when the weather is likely to be drier.
- Each time we use the Archery Lawn, we will offer to pay to remedy any irreversible damage caused by vehicles as a direct result of them parking for this event.

Traffic Management:

- We will place cones on the junction of Bramhall Park Road and Hall Road which is the main approach road to the car parks.
- The driveway between the top and lower car parks and Hall Road will be coned off in order to keep the road clear for emergency vehicles.
