1. INTRODUCTION AND PURPOSE OF REPORT

To approve the cost for the removal and placement of pedestrian safety barriers on Kirkstead Road in Cheadle Hulme.

2. INFORMATION

- 2.1 Network Management received representation for Hursthead School. They informed us that a review had been undertaken of disability access to the site, and a requirement had been identified to remove the existing barrier at the pedestrian entrance to the Infant School and erect safety barriers towards the kerb edge. The reason being that the current arrangement does not allow passage for wheelchairs.
- 2.2 Please see attached drawing number: **NM18-6281**. The associated cost for this scheme would be £460. The Ward Spokesperson has indicated that he is happy for this work to be funded from the delegated Ward Budget. Note: The existing barrier is within the Adopted Public Highway.
