

SEND JOINT STRATEGIC NEEDS ASSESSMENT (JSNA)

1. INTRODUCTION AND PURPOSE OF REPORT

- 1.1 The SEND Joint Strategic Needs Assessment (JSNA) has been produced following the recent OFSTED visit. It is a review of the current and future health and social care needs of the population aged 0 to 25 living with Special Educational Needs and Disability (SEND) in Stockport.
- 1.2 The JSNA has collected data from a range of sources including national and local datasets. It also includes the views of children and young people with SEND and their families.
- 1.3 The SEND JSNA will be presented as part of the Written Statement of Action
