**SCRUTINY REVIEWS**

The Scrutiny Committee in July 2019 proposed to the Scrutiny Co-ordination Committee who agreed in August 2019 that the Scrutiny Review for the Children and Families Scrutiny Committee for 2019/20 would be: -

- 1. Supporting Young People's Mental Wellbeing & Developing Resilience** (Panel to include Councillors Linda Holt (Lead), Laura Clingan, Yvonne Guariento and Becky Senior).
  - a. Scrutiny Review Panel met on 19 February 2020 and agreed the following: -

- i. **A One-Off Scrutiny Session** be arranged week commencing 23rd March 2020 – to have a ‘deep dive’ into the topic with officers and invited guests
  - ii. Following the One-Off Session a **draft report** would be prepared for Councillors on the review to consider for submission to the Children & Families Scrutiny Committee at its next meeting in April 2020.
2. Agreement be sought from the Children and Families Scrutiny Committee for a second scrutiny review to be held entitled “**Children & Young People’s Participation**” (see Items to be programmed above)
  - a. At the Scrutiny Review held on 19 February 2020, an update on the Children & Young People’s Participation was provided by Michelle Booth.
  - b. Scrutiny Review Panel members welcomed the information and agreed that approval be sought from the Scrutiny Committee for a “One-Off Scrutiny Session to be arranged in March/April 2020 (before the end of the municipal year)
  - c. Following this One-Off Session a draft report would be prepared for Councillors on the review to consider for submission to the Children & Families Scrutiny Committee at its next meeting.
