Summary: Stockport County Supporters Co-operative have applied to hold their annual half-marathon on Sunday 6 th September 2020 with a circular route being run from and back to Stockport County Football Club along the Trans Pennine Trail between the Woolpack Bridge through Mersey Vale and on into Manchester (see route map attached). The event will start at 9.30am and finish at 12.30pm, setting up from 8.30am.
Separate to this application event organisers will apply for temporary road closure orders along the route where appropriate via Highways. All the necessary permissions for the Manchester part of the route will be applied for and in place as in previous years prior to the event. Car parking space is available at nearby Edgeley car parks.
Prior to the event the organisers litter pick the whole route and remove any litter created as part of the event afterwards.
Event participants will pay an entry fee of £20 for runners affiliated to UK Athletics and £22 for non-affiliated runners with monies raised going towards the club and the Wellspring Homeless and Resource Centre, which is the chosen charity for the event. In addition, numerous charities will benefit, because a percentage of runners would participate on behalf of their own chosen charity and raise money via sponsorship. It is estimated that over £5,000 is raised for charities via sponsorship.
St Johns Ambulance will be providing the First Aid for the event, with qualified first-aiders on bicycles operating along the length of the route, with the main base and coordination at Stockport County Football Club.
