- Professor Dawn Edge of Manchester University working on Mental Health and Black Men research.
- Stockport MIND
- Healthwatch Stockport
- A local Prostrate Cancer survivor

The event will take place at: The Space, 26 St Petersgate, Stockport, SK1 1HD.

ACCA plan to hold regular event and presentations Bimonthly.

The event will be attended by local men, boys above 16years and women from African and Caribbean heritage.

10. Who will benefit from this grant?

e.g. local residents, young people, older people and how?

The people to benefit from this are local African and Caribbean men and boys over 16years. The event will be an opportunity to raise awareness of the signs and symptoms of mental health common with black men and boys to be delivered by Professor Dawn Edge who is a local Stockport resident.

Event will also raise important awareness around male cancers and how to access help and support. A local blackman who is a prostrate cancer survivor will share his experience and journey so far. He will explain the risk of prostate cancer, which has increased in black men and how a blood test from GP surgeries for PSA (prostate specific antigen) that is available to men over the age of 45 might save a life.

Prostate cancer is the most common cancer in men in the UK. Although it affects all men, black men are 2-3 times more likely to develop this cancer than their white counterparts. The death rate is twice as high. Furthermore, black men are more likely to develop prostate cancer at a younger age.

It is essential that black men, in particular, know about their increased risk of prostate cancer.

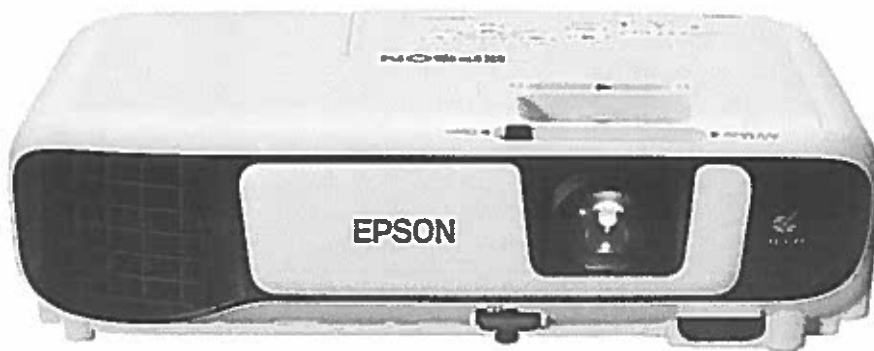
