Second phase of investigation/consultation to be undertaken with a view to extending the restrictions on the south easterly side of Manston Drive up to the access road leading to Regency Court. Traffic Regulation Order advertised with no objections. Work instruction issued to become operative March 2020. Works complete.

Results to be received March/April.
Finney Lane/Freshfield, Heald Green	11 May 2018	Proposals to amend the existing single yellow lines to double yellow lines up to Formby Drive. Site meeting took place on 24 May 2018 to discuss the issues. Investigation work being progressed. Proposal sent to Ward Spokesperson. Awaiting confirmation as to whether measures can be funded as part of the A6 to Manchester Airport Relief Road.
Smithy Croft, Heald Green	May 2018	Additional warning signage/road markings as there is a visibility issue. Site meeting took place on 24 May 2018 to discuss the issue. Investigation work being progressed. SLOW makings/elderly people warning signs being considered. Site visits to be undertaken to check if SLOW markings can be installed. Investigation will continue in spring 2020 once other schemes have been completed and an Officer becomes available.

Development taking place at this location on the former High Grove Public house site which is due to be completed imminently. Most of the vehicles appear to be contractor vehicles. Site observations confirmed that vehicles were parking on the bend but traffic was able to pass safely. Suggested to the Ward Spokesperson that the investigation can be closed.

Tatton Cinema, Gatley	August 2019	Traffic Regulation Orders as part of the Tatton Cinema redevelopment. A report was submitted to the last meeting of the Area Committee. Instructions sent to Legal Services to advertise the Traffic Regulation Order.

Consultation letters have been delivered to affected residents. Results to be reviewed January – March 2020. Report to be submitted to the next meeting of the Area Committee.
Twining Brook Road, Cheadle Hulme	March 2019	Issues with vehicles exiting Twining Brook Road at the junction with Ladybridge Road. Petition received from local residents. Once the investigation is complete a response will be provided in January – March 2020. Traffic movement surveys carried out at the junction in February. Plans to be drawn up showing visibility splays at the junction. Once complete a response will be provided in March/April.
