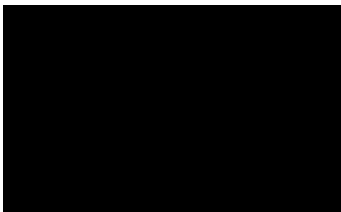

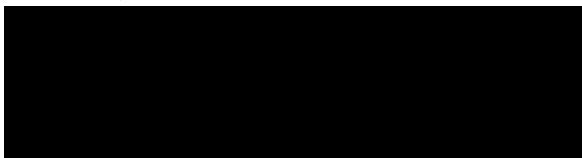

We ensure disabled children from birth to 25 have the opportunity to learn, play, build friendships, gain confidence and improve their well-being and we provide vital time, emotional and practical support to parents and siblings.

The KIDS Staying positive group in Stockport is aimed at addressing the gap in mental health outcomes for young disabled people (who are six times more likely than their non-disabled peers to develop a psychiatric disorder during adolescence) and to build their confidence and engagement with their community, the group continues to follow the NHS' Five Steps to Wellbeing model: **Connect; Be Active; Keep Learning; Give to Others; Be Mindful.**

The group has taken place every week in Woodbank Youth Centre in Stockport and has supported **30 young people aged 14-25** to improve their physical and emotional well-being – a **23%** increase on the number of young people supported last year. We have supported vulnerable and isolated young people with a range of disabilities including Autism, Downs Syndrome, Cerebral Palsy, Costello Syndrome, learning disabilities and range of complex needs.

The club provides a safe, supportive and most of all, fun environment where disabled young people can play, socialise, make new friends, learn new skills and gain independence.

The young people who attend can partake in social activities and practice key life skills such as decision making, money handling and travel training whilst enjoying fun, exciting and challenging activities.

At the club we rely heavily on IT to engage children with the most complex needs in educational activities & to develop their skills. Sadly we do not have the funding to purchase much needed IT equipment to enable all the children we support to have a more positive play and learning experience. We are asking if the Stockport Ward Flexibility fund would kindly donate £719.00 so that we can purchase an iPad pro for the club.
