The primary focus of this application is to enable path widening for disabled access to Moorfield Grove.

This phase of works will include:

- *Path widening, drainage to path*
- *Planting to area adjacent to 12 Moorfield Grove and some further local planting to enhance the local area*

Costings are in the annex.

We are an active group and as a group and as individuals we have made a number of improvements to the local area:

- *planting and continued maintenance to the land adjacent to 12 Moorfield Grove, improving the aspect to the area*
- *further planting of bulbs in the local area to Birch Avenue, behind the Plough etc.*
- *reduced width of hedge on Moorfield Grove to increase width of Moorfield Grove from Shaw Road to reduce the number of car bumps as cars reverse/park into Moorfield Grove*
- *improvements to road surface*
- *we are in the process of making the area a HomeWatch area*
- *signage identifying Moorfield Grove*

Who will benefit from e.g. this local grant? *residents, young people, older people and how? Improve safety and look of area.*

Widening of path will enable better access for all, residents, visitors, school children including wheelchair access – this will help reduce crimes and accidents at night - residents have previously sustained personal injury and access for emergency services such as ambulances has been hampered due to access issues.

10(a) How Many Stockport residents will benefit?

Through the year we estimate 10,000 individual walk-throughs - circa 30 per day. Primary benefit to 30 local residents with many more people using the path.

10(b) Are there any restrictions on who will benefit from the funding?

Everyone using this area would benefit, locals and visitors. This will prove of particular benefit with regard to disabled access/exit.

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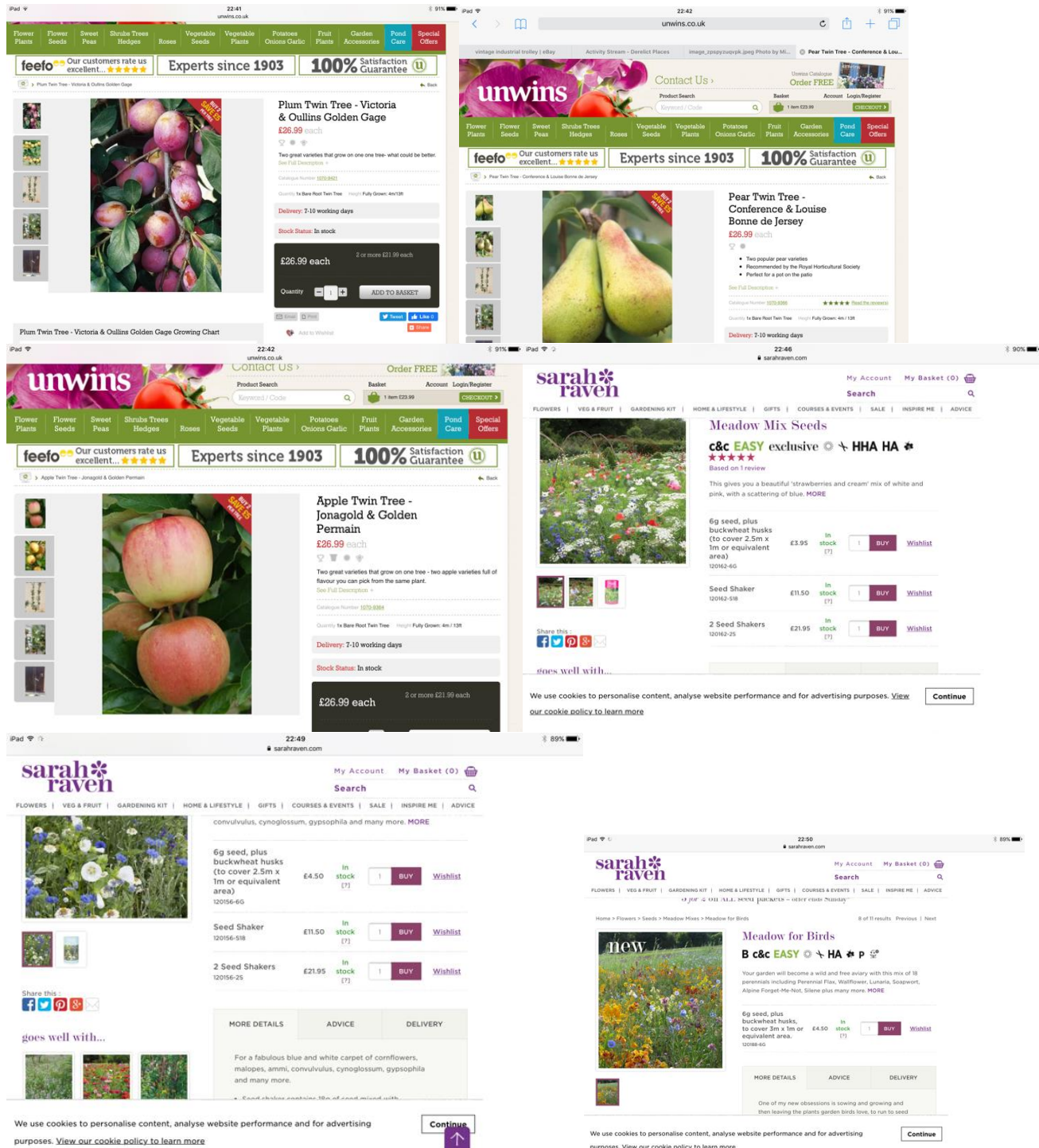

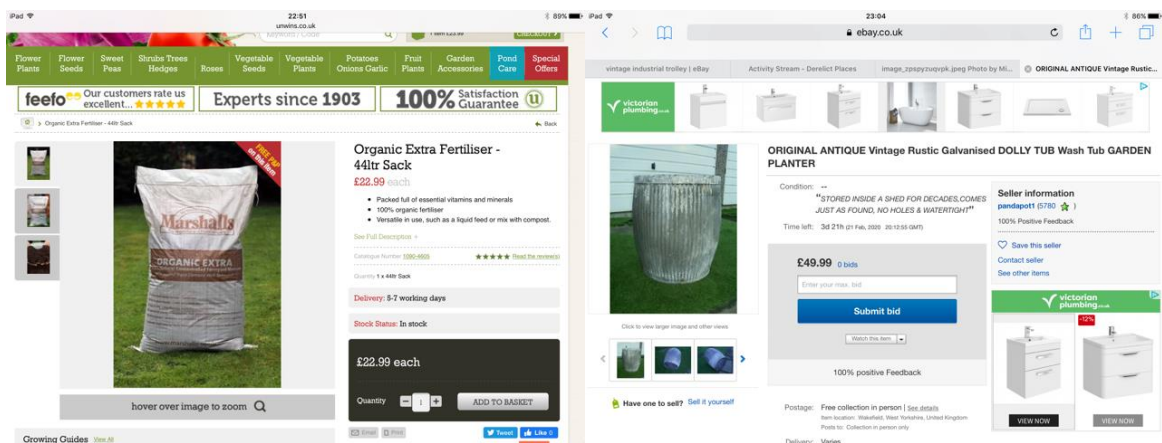
