Bramhall Park Road - Grass verge protection

Report of the Corporate Director for Place Management & Regeneration

1. INTRODUCTION AND PURPOSE OF REPORT

1.1 To provide the Area Committee with details of a proposed highway maintenance scheme on Bramhall Park Road, Bramhall North

2. BACKGROUND

- 2.1. In March 2019 the Area Committee approved the installation of 60 wooden posts on the grass verge along Bramhall Park Road from the junction of Low Wood Close to Linney Road, due to vehicles continually parking on and damaging the grass verges along Bramhall Park Road.
- 2.2. The installation of the above posts moved parked vehicles further along and on request of the Councillor responsible for highways, Network Management have prepared an estimate for the installation of wooden posts along the other grass verges on Bramhall Park Road.

3. PROPOSALS

3.1. Installation of 47 wooden posts to the grass verges on Bramhall Park Road from its junction of Broomhill Drive to the bridge (on both sides).
