Natalie's Dance Creative is a Community Interest Company (CIC) set up to deliver dance classes to the children and youth in Stockport. As a CIC the benefit of the users is at the heart of what we do with all monies fed back into the company for their benefit only. Stockport as an area is deprived with many users from low income households who are restricted to outer activity usage due to cost. In addition to this daily struggle these users also face the adaptation of living in this generation where pressures of social behaviours are predetermined stereotypes of who they are. NDC has an aim, to give these users yes a dance studio but also a place of safety to speak freely, develop as role models for their generation and break the tag of a typical kid in 2020. Stockport does not offer guidance, opportunities or inclusion for many if not all of this generation and we at NDC with hard work and strength will give them and their families what they need to succeed. We offer classes in commercial, street and contemporary and our dancers compete at National Championships twice a year.
