| Lum Head Primary School, Troutbeck Road and Cheadle Primary School, Ashfield Road | 25 June 2018 | Site investigation work to be carried out and meeting required with school to discuss issues. The school will be evaluated to see if it can be added to the 2019/2020 Road Safety around Schools Programme. |
| Councillor Lane service road. | 15 June 2018 | One Way Issue. Investigate and look at ordering a traffic survey for one week's worth of data. Traffic count carried out in September/October.
