1.0 PURPOSE OF REPORT

- 1.1 To provide the Area Committee with details of a proposed highway maintenance scheme on Maxwell Avenue, Great Moor.

- 2.1 Highway Officers have prepared an estimate for a proposed Local Initiative scheme in response to a specific request from Members of this Area Committee. Details of the scheme are provided below.

- 3.1 The following would be funded by this Area Committee's Highway Maintenance and Traffic Management delegated budget:-

Stepping Hill Ward

Resurface from 14/16 Maxwell Avenue in Great Moor to the cul de sac end.

Budget breakdown:-

The cost of the scheme would be £ 12,500 if approved. Should this be approved with a scheme on Aber Avenue there will be £2,740 left in the Ward budget.
