

IMPACTS OF COVID-19 ON HEALTH AND WELLBEING IN STOCKPORT**Report of the Service Director Strategy and Commissioning****1. INTRODUCTION AND PURPOSE OF REPORT**

- 1.1 The COVID-19 Global Pandemic has already had a significant impact on all our lives. Although challenging, we have seen public services, communities and businesses come together to support each other and protect the most vulnerable. The One Stockport movement has emerged from this, celebrating the local response and action as a call of action to encourage people to support each other and their local businesses, communities, families and neighbours.
- 1.2 Over the past 4 months, the One Stockport movement has gained momentum and a wide range of engagement has been undertaken. The attached report provides an overview of some of the work to date and next steps. The One Stockport brochure is included as appendix 1 and outlines the draft vision and values. The Brochure also introduces the Borough Plan which is one of the outcomes of the One Stockport movement.
- 1.3 The Borough Plan is a strategic partnership document that outlines collective priorities for the borough. It is developed in partnership with public services, businesses and communities. Despite the current pressures, colleagues from across the borough had continued to state a strong commitment to the development of a new borough plan for Stockport. It feels more important than ever to set out our commitment to build back a stronger Stockport and an optimistic future.
- 1.4 Therefore, the second part of the presentation outlines the timeline and activity to develop the borough plan. It also outlines some early findings from the engagement work and the development of the big Stockport picture a new data hub that will underpin the borough plan and as part of One Stockport it will provide data and intelligence that can be accessed by everyone.
