- 3.1 The following would be funded by this Area Committee's Highway Maintenance and Traffic Management delegated budget:-

Heatons North – Wingate Road/Princes Road = £530

Heatons South – Pleachway/Park Row/Park Place/Vale Close/ 8-10 Ridgmont Close (off Winchester Drive) = £265

Reddish South – Victoria Road/Brook Road/Reddish Vale Road (school down to farm) = £530

Ward balance available:-

Heatons North - £10,541.00

Heatons South - £12,298.00

Reddish South - £11,060.00
