Summary:

The Planning and Compulsory Purchase Act (2004) (as amended) requires the Council to publish a Statement of Community Involvement (SCI) detailing how they will engage local communities and other interested parties in producing their Local Plan and determining planning applications. The council are required to adhere to the adopted SCI when undertaking consultation in relation to these activities.

An addendum to the SCI (2015) is proposed to deal with the constraints on undertaking community involvement which arise from the Health Protection (Coronavirus) Regulations 2020. The addendum also contains a number of other proposed clauses which seek to align the SCI more closely with the Town and Country Planning (Local Plan) (England) Regulations 2012 where amendments to those regulations have been made since the SCI was last updated in 2015.
