# COUNCIL SIZE SUBMISSION REPORT IN RESPONSE TO LOCAL GOVERNMENT BOUNDARY COMMISSION REQUIREMENT FOR REVIEW

Meeting: 8 December 2020

# 1. INTRODUCTION AND PURPOSE OF REPORT

- 1.1 The Local Government Boundary Commission for England ("the Commission") is an independent body, responsible for determining electoral arrangements of local authorities across England.
- 1.2 The Local Democracy, Economic Development and Construction Act 2009 ("the Act") outlines the duty on the Commission to undertake an electoral review of every principal local authority in England 'from time to time'.
- 1.3 Many metropolitan districts have not been reviewed since the Commission's predecessor body undertook a review of all local authorities in England between 1996 and 2004; Stockport's last electoral review was completed in 2003. The Commission intends to review all authorities that have not been reviewed since that time, and thus have decided to undertake an electoral review of Stockport in 2020/21.
- 1.4 The purpose of this report is to propose the draft Council Size Submission Report for approval at the Council Meeting on 21 January 2021 prior to a final version being submitted to the Commission on 2 February 2021.
- 1.5 A previous working draft was provided to Group Leaders for comments and was then appended to a Briefing Report that went to CRMG Scrutiny Committee on 17 December 2019. A further progress update report went to CRMG Scrutiny Committee on 3 March 2020. Work on the review then paused due to the pandemic.
