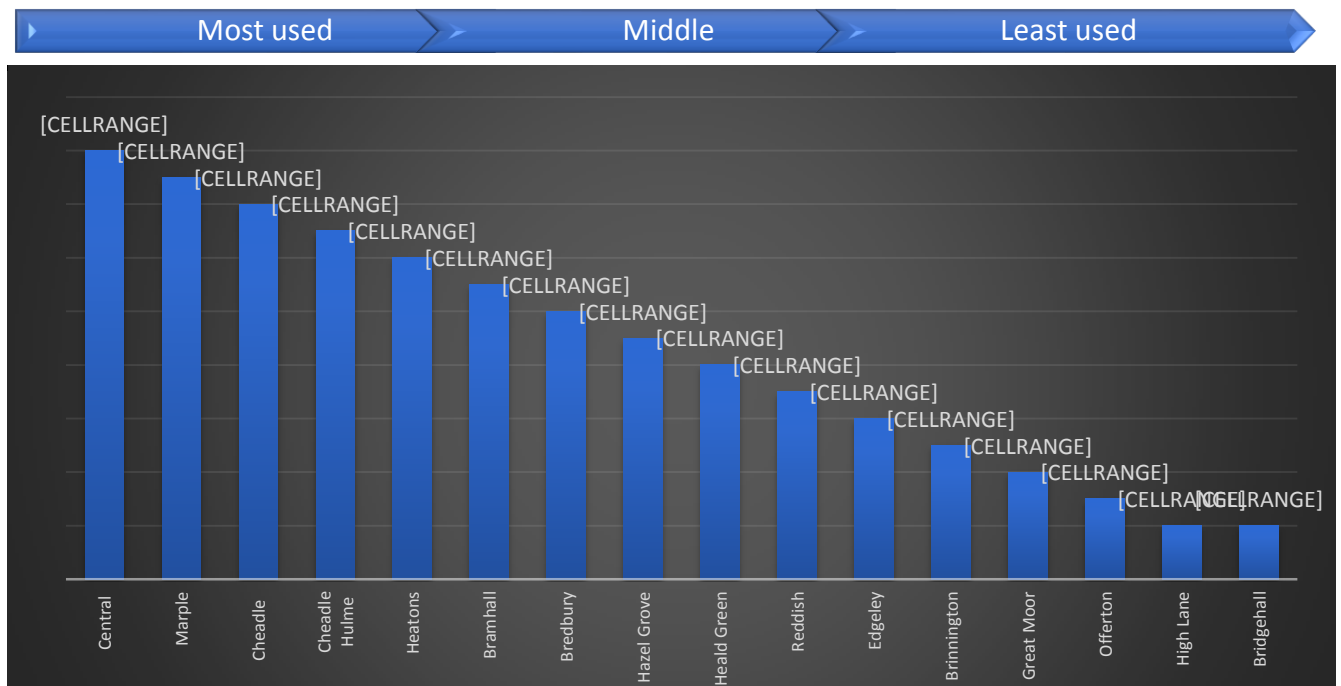


CHART 1: DEMAND ANALYSIS

The unique number of people using digital equipment (only counted once).

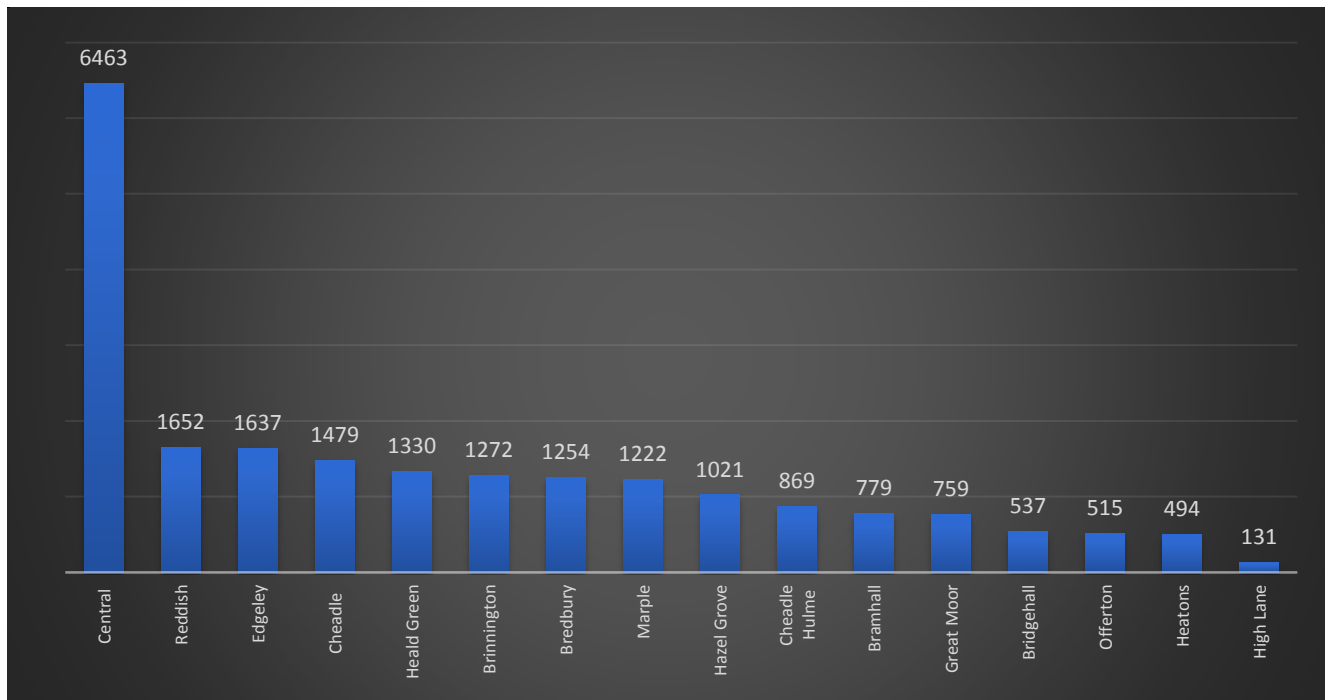


CHART 2 CITIZENS USING DIGITAL IN LIBRARY BUILDINGS
