In January 2020 the Stockport Garrick was contractually committed to a £250,000.00 spend to renovate the delapidated and unsafe basement. The aim is to bring the area back into use as a dedicated rehearsal and performance space for youth theatre and community groups throughout each year. We were in receipt of grants totaling 45,000 from Garfield Weston and Foyle Foundations, conditional oncompleting planned works before the end of the year. We also utilised membership donations and reserves built up over a number of years, and a loan from the CAF Bank of £100,000. Due to Government lockdown in March 2020 the theatre has lost valuable income, estimated at over £30,000 from cancelled performances, loss of wardrobe hire and cancelled theatre outside lets. We were planning to open again in January 2021 subject to government guidance, although the latest guidance suggests we may have another 6 months before we will be able to open.

Nevertheless, we intend to continue fundraising to complete the basement project. Our recent crowd funding project is estimated to have achieved a total of £8737.50 including Gift aid. A contribution from the Ward Flexibility Funding would be very gratefully received. Immediately, we need to install a dedicated security alarm (estimated £1415.92) and to lay flooring over the newly-laid concrete base (estimated at £11466.98).

The Stockport Garrick Theatre was founded in 1901 and moved into our current premises in 1921, since when we have made several alterations and improvements to achieve the modern facilities used today by different local groups. We want to continue to improve the facilities, but we have severely limited income at present due to Covid-19. We still have regular outgoings such as utility bills and mortgage repayments.

The Garrick is run entirely by volunteers who usually pay a small subscription to be a member. At its core the Garrick is about community and friendship, giving people of all ages confidence and increasing social skills to tackling social exclusion and isolation. Outside lets also bring in a diverse range of people. Our studio is used regularly by our own Youth Theatre group. Local dance schools have used our main stage for their annual shows, and local theatres such as the Stockport Plaza and The Lowry Theatre Salford have used our theatre for rehearsal space. The newly refurbished Basement will provide the potential to accommodate more such activities. We know social involvement and drama activities combat loneliness, and improve individuals self-esteem and confidence. One example of such projects was our 2018 New Writing week aimed at people who otherwise might think drama was not for them (rather as people used to view opera?) or were priced out of similar mainstream opportunities. It offered mentoring for playwrights, professionally tutored development workshops, rehearsal and performance opportunities.

We are keen to build community involvement; we were Involved as a venue as part of Stock-port's 2019 Purple Flag award for evening entertainment. Also we are involved with Stockport's Cultural network. We will be partnering with the Spinning Top as a venue for the Stockport Blues Festival planned in May (postponed from September).



10. Who will benefit from this grant?

Our original Vision was to create a fully equipped new space which can be used flexibly by different sized groups at different times, for every stage from meeting to conference, from rehearsal through to performance - we're on the way to that, (currently can use for about 30/40 people) but we are necessarily having to do things in stages. Safety and rehearsal capacity first! The newly refurbished Basement will benefit local residents, young and old, who come to the Garrick either as members of the theatre, or as part of our youth group, or as members of local groups who wish to hire the Garrick basement for meetings, rehearsals or arts-based activities. **Prime targets**: youth and community groups, arts biased but not exclusively, with a focus on developing drama skills, dance, creativity, mental wellbeing, countering social isolation / loneliness. Projects such as our 2018 New Writing week for aspiring community writers will be able to run alongside main theatre activities- no longer competing for rehearsal and performance space.

10(a) How Many Stockport residents will benefit?

We hope that if the basement is used regularly by the groups of between 20 and 30 envisaged, there could be an uptake of ten groups per week giving the potential for 250 people to benefit. In addition our current youth groups would add another 93 to that estimate. There would also be the additional potential for larger groups of residents to benefit for one-off occasions.

10(b) Are there any restrictions on who will benefit from the funding?

Due to the nature of the building and current regulations we cannot provide wheelchair access.

We also have a loan from the CAF Bank of £100,000. Our recent crowd funding project is estimated to have achieved a total of £8737.50 including Gift aid.
