**1.0 MATTER FOR CONSIDERATION**

- 1.1 To provide the Area Committee with details of a proposed lighting upgrade on the footpath between Mallard Close and Whimbrel Road.

- 2.1 Network Asset Maintenance Officers have prepared a lighting design with an estimate for a proposed delegated budget scheme in response to a specific request from Members of this Area Committee. Details of the scheme are provided below.

- 3.1 The following would be funded by this Area Committee's Highway Maintenance and Traffic Management delegated budget:-

**Offerton Ward**

The proposal is to install two new lighting columns with LED lanterns and associated ducting along the footpath between Mallard Close and Whimbrel Road.

Budget breakdown:-

The estimated cost to carry out the work above would be £6,420.

The current Offerton Ward balance available is £16,718.00.
