6. Please describe the main activities of your Organisation/ Group

New Horizons is a canal boat and was commissioned in 1981 by H.R.H. the Prince of Wales. It is operated by a registered charity, Stockport Canal Boat Trust for Disabled People, created by the then Mayor of Stockport the late L. Gordon Bayley M.B.E. whose charity appeal raised the money to build this specially designed boat.

New Horizons offers Day, Half Day and Evening trips from April to October and is a key part of many local events in the Marple area. Operating a canal boat is not just time consuming, it's expensive and the Trust is heavily reliant on funds raised through donations and by volunteers to maintain its operation. Unscheduled emergencies like the loss of the propeller cause a significant strain on resources. The Trust is financially independent. It depends entirely on donations, bequests and sponsorship from individuals, businesses and charitable organisations to meet its operating cost. The pandemic meant that the 2020 cruising season was seriously constrained with non of our usual fundraising opportunities.

9. Please give us a brief description of your proposed/planned project or activity

In 2021 Stockport Canal Boat Trust will celebrate its 40th Birthday. 40 years of community boating in Marple. A significant event for both the Trust and for Marple. We want to make this a full year of celebration and are organising events and trips accordingly. Events at the mooring, on the canal and as a part of other local activities, We have planned community trips linked to the Co-op local causes scheme.

The request here is for funding to supply banners / signage for the mooring for the 2021 season and a permanent commemorative plaque to enhance the boat.

10. Who will benefit from this grant?

Marple residents will benefit from the 40th year celebrations, users of the boat and the wharf will benefit from an enhanced environment.

10(a) How Many Stockport residents will benefit?

In a normal season we carry 2000 passengers. In the 40th year with additional usage through the community trips we would hope to exceed that.

10(b) Are there any restrictions on who will benefit from the funding?

Aesthetically no the banners will improve the mooring. The trips offered as part of the 40th anniversary year will comply with our normal booking criteria.
