Highways Maintenance Local Initiative Report

Report of the Corporate Director for Place Management & Regeneration

1.0 PURPOSE OF REPORT

1.1 To provide the Area Committee with details of a proposed Local Initiative scheme at Romiley (Birch Avenue) Allotments.

2.0 BACKGROUND

- 2.1 After a series of break-ins at the Allotment site at the end of 2020 and early 2021, a need has been identified to improve the fencing at the Allotment site.
- 2.2 Neighbourhood Officers have prepared an estimate for a proposed Local Initiative scheme in response to a specific request from Members of this Area Committee.
- 2.3 A first phase of fencing would be installed along the boundary with Tangshutts Fields. This initial estimate is for £12,600. However, it is expected that Romiley Allotment Association will raise funds and obtain grant monies from other sources to contribute towards this amount.
- 2.4 The Area Committee is being requested to make a contribution of £5,000 towards the scheme.

3.0 PROPOSED WORK

3.1 The following would be partially funded by this Area Committee's Highway Maintenance and Traffic Management delegated budget:-

Clearance of vegetation and old fencing including removal of old concrete posts along 110m fence line. Installation of green palisade fencing.

Bredbury Green and Romiley Ward

A contribution towards the cost of the installation of new security fencing along the boundary of the Allotment site with Tangshutt Fields. = £5,000.

Budget breakdown:-Current budget available £ 16,988.

4.0 **RECOMMENDATION**

4.1 That the Area Committee supports the maintenance scheme outlined in the report and authorises the Corporate Director for Place Management & Regeneration to order the work, once all funds have been raised.
