Benches in the North Heatons Area - Moor Top Shops Area

Report of the Corporate Director for Place Management & Regeneration

1.0 **PURPOSE OF REPORT**

1.1 To provide the Area Committee with details of a proposed highway maintenance scheme at Moor Top Shops Area

2.0 **BACKGROUND**

2.1 The Neighbourhood Project Officers have prepared an estimate for a proposed Local Initiative scheme in response to a specific request from Members of this Area Committee. Details of the scheme are provided below.

3.0 **PROPOSED WORK**

3.1 The following would be funded by this Area Committee's Highway Maintenance and Traffic Management delegated budget:-

Heatons North Ward

Following on from the benches requested and agreed at the previous Heatons and Reddish Area Committee on 1st February 2021, Item 9, the Spokesperson for Heatons North has requested further benches due to the lack of seating facilities in the North Heatons Ward in the Moor Top Shops Area and near to the Savoy Cinema.

In consultation with the Spokesperson and Network Assets, the following locations have been identified as suitable for the installation of a seating facility:

- Moor Top Shops x 2 Highway style benches on the large open paved area between Moortop, Launderama and the Co op.
- Moor Top x 1 Highway style bench near to the Savoy Cinema

The Highway style bench is supplied by Ogilvie KC and has been selected as they are a steel construction and designed to be vandal resistant. However, it should be noted that due to limited maintenance funds, should any of the benches be vandalised beyond repair they will not be replaced.

Budget breakdown:-

Cost of works £3,300.00 and includes the supply and installation of 3 x Highway Benches at £1,100 per bench.

Available budget Heatons North £4,411.00
