Report of the Deputy Chief Executive

1.0 PURPOSE OF REPORT

1.1 To provide the Area Committee with details of a proposed lighting upgrade on Alderley Road in Reddish.

2.0 BACKGROUND

Network Asset Maintenance Officers have prepared a lighting design with an estimate for a proposed delegated budget scheme in response to a specific request from Members of this Area Committee. Details of the scheme are provided below.

3.0 PROPOSED WORK

3.1 The following would be funded by this Area Committee's Highway Maintenance and Traffic Management delegated budget:-

Reddish South Ward

The proposal is to install a new lighting column with an LED lantern outside 37/39 Alderley Road.

The estimated cost to carry out the work above would be approximately £1,700.

The current Reddish South Ward balance available is approximately £8,300.

Additional works will be carried out to relocate and replace two other lighting columns which will be funded separately.
