STOCKPORT HOMES DELIVERY PLAN 2021-2026

1. INTRODUCTION AND PURPOSE OF REPORT

- 1.1 The Management Agreement between the Council and Stockport Homes requires Stockport Homes to produce a Delivery Plan every five years, with an interim review at year 3 and annual reports to the Council setting out the progress made against the plan. This new plan will run from 2021-2026, with a review scheduled for 2023/4 to ensure the plan remains relevant and aligned to Council priorities and objectives, and to incorporate any new objectives/actions.
- 1.2 The Delivery Plan sets out the actions Stockport Homes will take to properly and effectively manage and maintain the Council's housing stock, and how it will work to support and deliver the wider strategic objectives of the Council and the Borough Plan. The Delivery Plan has been developed in close consultation with the Council and provides the basis against which the Council can measure the progress and effectiveness of Stockport Homes.
