Report of the Corporate Director for Place Management & Regeneration

1.0 <u>PURPOSE OF REPORT</u>

1.1 To provide the Area Committee with details of a proposed highway maintenance scheme at Mersey Vale Nature Park.

2.0 BACKGROUND

- 2.1 The locks on the main entrance gate to Mersey Vale Nature Park have recently been broken rendering the existing access point insecure.
- 2.2 It is proposed to replace the existing two leaf entrance gates with a more robust barrier.

3.0 PROPOSED WORK

3.1 The following would be funded by this Area Committee's Highway Maintenance and Traffic Management delegated budget:-

Heatons South Ward

- The manufacture, supply and installation of a more robust barrier to replace the existing 2 leaf entrance gates to site
- Specification manufacture and fit 1 No. low level single leaf heavy duty swing beam vehicle control barrier to suit a 3metre opening
- Hanging post in 120 x 120 x 5 RHS, Barrier in 80 x 80 x RHS c/w Integral padlock enclosure to allow locking in both open and closed positions. Hung from M24 Gr. 8.8 High tensile fabricated adjustable screw eye hangers and 25mm Diameter gudgeon pins c/w Anti-lift collars. All complete with 120 x 120 x 5 locking post and 1no 80 x 80 locking post for open position. Allow for lock cover.
- All to be Hot-Dip Galvanised and finished in Corporate Green

Associated costs - £2,640.00

4.0 <u>RECOMMENDATION</u>

4.1 That the Area Committee supports the maintenance scheme outlined in the report and authorises the Corporate Director for Place Management & Regeneration to order the work at a cost of £2,640.00 to be funded from the Area Committee's Delegated Budget (Heatons South ward allocation).
