Summary:

The purpose of this report is to share a final draft of Stockport's **One Health and Care Plan** with Members. The plan has been developed over the course of the past 8 months and is one of a suite of documents that will support the delivery of the One Stockport Borough Plan.

The draft plan has been developed jointly by Stockport Council, the Clinical Commissioning Group and the Foundation Trust and brings together the Health and Wellbeing Strategy, the Population Health Plan and the Locality Plan into one cohesive document. The plan takes into account feedback and learning from a variety of sources, including an extensive engagement programme with Stockport residents, the workforce, other partners and stakeholders.

The Clinical Commissioning Group and the Foundation Trust are currently in the process of going through their own internal governance arrangements, concurrent to the Council's process-ready for final sign off at the Health and Wellbeing Board on 13th October 2021.

The One Health and Care Plan demonstrates the commitment of our partners to work in a collaborative and innovative way, ensuring that the focus is on improving outcomes for the residents of Stockport; reducing health inequalities and embracing opportunities in relation to digital inclusion and early intervention and prevention.
