5. APPEAL A239

The Committee considered an appeal against dismissal from an employee of the Adults & Communities Directorate. The appellant and her representative attended the meeting and presented her case.

It was then

RESOLVED – That having listened to all that was said at the meeting and having read all the written evidence submitted, the Committee determined that they could not uphold the appeal.

On balance of probabilities the Committee believes that the appellant's alleged abuse of a manager did take place, but that on its own this would not normally be sufficient cause for your dismissal.

The Committee also believes that on the evidence that has arisen that the appellant lied during a formal investigation procedure. Again, this may not on its own have been sufficient to result in the appellant's dismissal.

Employment Appeals Committee – 17 March 2009

In relation to the mileage claim, the Committee believes that the appellant had submitted these fraudulently and that the appellant's actions accordingly constituted gross misconduct. The Committee therefore upheld management's decision to summarily dismiss the appellant for gross misconduct in accordance with management's letter.
