## 4. HOUSING APPEAL

The appellant and her representative attended the meeting, presented her case and answered members' questions in relation to her case. The Director of Community Services submitted a report (copies of which had been circulated) explaining to the Panel the reason for his decision. He also attended the meeting and answered members questions.

The appeal was against a decision of the Director of Community Services who had upheld a decision made by Housing Advice that the appellant was not homeless in accordance with the definition in Section 175 of the Housing Act 1996. The Committee considered carefully all the oral and written evidence submitted.

RESOLVED - That the appeal against the decision of the Director of Community Services be upheld and as a matter of urgency, the Director of Community Services be requested to provide housing for the appellant as near to her son's school as possible. The Committee was of the opinion that it was not reasonable in accordance with Section 175 (3) of the Housing Act 1996 for the appellant to continue to occupy the accommodation and therefore the appellant should be considered as homeless.
