1. MINUTES

3. COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT

(i) Chair's Announcements

The Chair reported that the 'You Say We Pay' which took place on Saturday 24 July at Dial park Primary school had been a great success Residents had been able to vote on which community groups received funding for projects on the Offerton Estate. As a result a number of events including fun days and football tournaments had been held over the summer all of which had been well received in the local community and well attended.

(ii) Neighbourhood Policing

PCSO Andy Goodwin (Greater Manchester Police) attended the meeting to answer questions from Councillors and members of the public in relation to Neighbourhood Policing issues within the Offerton Ward. The following issues were discussed/ issues raised:

- Burglary of dwellings and theft of motor vehicles
- Large numbers of youth gathering outside the Co-op on Fulmar Drive for an organised fight and the issuing of direction to leave notices. One youth arrested following the failure to comply with the direction to leave notice.
- An arrest on Bean Leach Road for erratic driving.
- Burglaries relating to insecurities
- The recent spate of armed robberies in Stockport and the subsequent arrest of eight people
- Patrols on Owens Farm Drive - investigations in relation to complaints of youth taking drugs near to the pond / camping and rod licensing
- The need for the public to report any instances of anti-social behaviour
- Problems associated with parking on The Fairway particularly during school drop off and pick up times

RESOLVED - That the PCSO Andy Goodwin (Greater Manchester Police) be thanked for his attendance and the Ward Committees concern at the problems associated with

illegal parking on The Fairway during school drop off and pick up times be referred to the Service Director (Environment).
