The A6MARR scheme has the necessary powers in place to deliver the scheme and the air quality issues were addressed through the course of the planning application process and associated CPO/SRO public inquiry where questions were raised with the project team on this matter. The development of the Complimentary & Mitigation Measures is being progressed by the relevant local authorities, specifically with respect to the mitigation measures that will be implemented prior to road opening. Consultation and preliminary design has been initiated on these mitigation measures with regard to developing the final design and subsequent implementation prior to road opening as per the relevant planning conditions.
