Subject: Better Care Fund 20/21 Financial Planning and Q3 Forecast

1. Purpose

1.1 To receive the Better Care Fund (BCF) financial planning for 2020/21 and provide an update on the finance performance of the BCF as at 31 December 2020 (Quarter 3).

2. Introduction

- 2.1. In response to the Covid-19 pandemic NHSE/I have confirmed that formal BCF plans will not need to be submitted for approval at a regional or national level in 2020/21 and that systems should prioritise continuity of provision, social care capacity and system resilience and with local agreement roll forward schemes from 2019/20 where appropriate.
- 2.2. However HWB are required to ensure that the use of the mandatory funding contributions (CCG minimum contribution, improved Better Care Fund (iBCF) grant and the Disabled Facilities Grant) has been agreed in writing, and that the national conditions are met.
- 2.3. Systems will be required to submit an end of year reconciliation confirming that the national conditions have been met, total spend from the mandatory funding sources and a breakdown of agreed spending on social care from the CCG minimum contribution.
- 2.4. The national conditions for the BCF in 2020/21 are that:
 - Plans covering all mandatory funding contributions have been agreed by HWB areas and minimum contributions are pooled in a section 75 agreement (an agreement made under section 75 of the NHS Act 2006).
 - The contribution to social care from the CCG via the BCF is agreed and meets or exceeds the minimum expectation.
 - Spend on CCG commissioned out of hospital services meets or exceeds the minimum ringfence.
 - CCGs and local authorities confirm compliance with the above conditions to their Health and Wellbeing Boards.

3. Financial Planning 2020/21

3.1. The 2019 spending round confirmed that CCG minimum contribution to the BCF must increase by 5.3% (£1.108m) to £22.191m in 2020/21 with the minimum contribution to social care from CCG via the BCF for 2020/21 increasing to £9.458m and the minimum spend on CCG commissioned out of hospital services increasing to £6.306m.

3.2. The BCF Financial Plan 2020/21 detailed at Appendix 1 meets national conditions in respect to minimum contributions, improved Better Care Fund (iBCF) and the Disabled Facilities Grant. The 5.3% increase in the BCF has been applied to individual schemes commensurate with the individual scheme cost pressures and inflationary uplifts.

4. Q3 Financial Performance

- 4.1. The actual spend as at the end of Q3 is £24.028m, an underspend of £1.849m against the planned figure of £25.877m. The underspend is due to a combination of the phasing of expenditure aligned to winter plan funding, where commitments are predominantly over the winter period and an underspend with the Disabled Facilities Grant (DFG) (capital funding).
- 4.2. Forecast outturn expenditure is £33.016m against an annual plan of £34.502m, a forecast under spend of £1.486m as detailed in Table 1.

4.4. Council

<u>Disabled Facilities Grant (DFG) – capital - underspend of £1.486m</u>

The DFG forecast includes the additional £0.342m the Council has received from the announcement on the 8th December by MHCLG of an additional £68m nationally for the DFG in 2020/21.

There has been a significant impact on the delivery of the DFG programme in 2020/21 due to Covid-19. This includes challenges within the assessment process due in part to residents shielding, risk assessments are being carried out to mitigate these factors, with alternative measures put in place where possible, however this has resulted in an overall reduction in requests.

The DFG continues to support mandatory provision alongside capital investment into a number of appropriate non-mandatory schemes aligned to Adult Social Care. Further collaboration is taking place between a number of Council services to continue to develop innovative schemes to support individuals at home.

Alongside this are a number of other capital programmes which align to associated grant conditions, which includes for example investment into the Care Academy at the former St Thomas's site.

The DFG 2020/21 balance will be utilised to support the various schemes which are being developed for consideration.

4.5. Stockport CCG

All CCG commissioned schemes are spending in line with plan.

Additional detail of the BCF financial performance by scheme is provided in Appendix 2.

5. Recommendations

- 5.1 The Board are recommended to:
 - (i) Approve the BCF 2020/21 Financial Planning.
 - (ii) To note the finance performance of the BCF as at 31 December 2020 (Quarter 3).



Assistive Technologies and Equipment	Using technology in care processes to supportive self-management, maintenance of independence and more efficient and effective delivery of care. (eg. Telecare, Wellness services, Digital participation services).	
Care Act Implementation Related Duties	Funding planned towards the implementation of Care Act related duties.	
Carers Services	Supporting people to sustain their role as carers and reduce the likelihood of crisis. Advice, advocacy, information, assessment, emotional and physical support, training, access to services to support wellbeing and improve independence. This also includes the implementation of the Care Act as a sub-type.	
Community Based Schemes	Schemes that are based in the community and constitute a range of cross sector practitioners delivering collaborative services in the community typically at a neighbourhood level (eg: Integrated Neighbourhood Teams)	
DFG Related Schemes	The DFG is a means-tested capital grant to help meet the costs of adapting a property; supporting people to stay independent in their own homes.	

Enablers for Integration	Schemes that build and develop the enabling foundations of health and social care integration encompassing a wide range of potential areas including technology, workforce, market development (Voluntary Sector Business Development: Funding the business development and preparedness of local voluntary sector into provider Alliances/ Collaboratives) and programme management related schemes. Joint commissioning infrastructure includes any personnel or teams that enable joint commissioning. Also, the assistance offered to people in navigating through the complex health and social care systems (across primary care, community and voluntary services and social care) to overcome barriers in accessing the most appropriate care and support. Multi-agency teams typically provide these services which can be online or face to face care navigators for frail elderly, or dementia navigators etc. This includes approaches like Single Point of Access (SPoA) and linking people to community assets. Integrated care planning constitutes a co-ordinated, person centred and proactive case management approach to conduct joint assessments of care needs and develop integrated care plans typically carried out by professionals as part of a multi-disciplinary, multi-agency teams. Intermediate Care Services	Short-term intervention to preserve the independence of people who might otherwise face unnecessarily prolonged hospital stays or avoidable admission to hospital or residential care. The care is person-centred and often delivered by a combination of professional groups. Four service models of intermediate care are: bed-based intermediate care, crisis or rapid response (including falls), home-based intermediate care, and reablement or rehabilitation. Home-based intermediate care is covered in Scheme-A and the other three models are available on the sub-types.	



Personalised Budgeting and Commissioning	Various person centred approaches to commissioning and budgeting.	
Personalised Care at Home	Schemes specifically designed to ensure that a person can continue to live at home, through the provision of health related support at home often complemented with support for home care needs or mental health needs. This could include promoting self-management/expert patient, establishment of 'home ward' for intensive period or to deliver support over the longer term to maintain independence or offer end of life care for people. Intermediate care services provide shorter term support and care interventions as opposed to the ongoing support provided in this scheme type.	
Prevention / Early Intervention	Services or schemes where the population or identified high-risk groups are empowered and activated to live well in the holistic sense thereby helping prevent people from entering the care system in the first place. These are essentially upstream prevention initiatives to promote independence and well being.	
Residential Placements	Residential placements provide accommodation for people with learning or physical disabilities, mental health difficulties or with sight or hearing loss, who need more intensive or specialised support than can be provided at home.
