# Report of the Corporate Director for Place Management & Regeneration

### 1. INTRODUCTION AND PURPOSE OF REPORT

1.1 To seek approval to erect 26 no. wooden posts along the edge of 6 grassed verges located on Turves Road, Cheadle.

### 2. BACKGROUND

Traffic Services have been advised that vehicles are mounting a number of grassed verges on Turves Road, Cheadle Hulme and in doing so, are damaging the grass. This was evident during the site visit, where cars overrun and parked here causing mud and divots within the verge. Besides this being unsightly, vehicle overrun on verges can compact soil and affect its structure and drainage qualities.

# 3. PROPOSALS

- 3.1. In order to prevent vehicles from mounting the grassed verge it is proposed to install 3 no. wooden posts along the edge of the verge as shown on **Drawing No. NM18-Turves Road, Cheadle Hulme-01**.
- 3.2. Although verge protection methods such as posts can prevent a driven lawn mower from cutting the verge, strimmers can be used instead. However, as strimmers are a more time consuming and costly way of grass cutting, posts and signs are only installed where there is a persistent parking problem and grass around posts may not be cut regularly.
