In order to be able to offer a full programme of coaching and training, and open up as much of the ground as possible to new members we simply have to get our practice nets back in action.

#### 10. Who will benefit from this grant?

e.g. local residents, young people, older people and how?

Covid-19 has affected everyone in our community to varying degrees. We want to play our part in helping the recovery. As a community sports club we see our primary role will be to help those who have been isolated or become less active (physically and socially) to find a safe and welcoming place to re-engage and hopefully improve fitness and mental wellbeing as a result.

Our facilities are currently a restriction in this effort because we cannot host any larger scale practice nights, Junior Cricket sessions run by Cheshire Cricket Board, nor can the practice ground be accessed on match days. This means our reach in the community is more limited.

By improving our facilities, we are confident we can attract new members, and they and their families can then access the club as a social hub.

There are hundreds of new homes being developed within 1 square mile of our ground but no plans that we are aware of to introduce new sporting facilities, making our ground a key asset as the population grows. The demographic of these new homeowners is likely to be families and young people that we are seeking to attract.

#### 10(a) How Many Stockport residents will benefit?

The club is accessible by all local residents so our reach is significant. Based upon likely membership, connected families and our social events we would envisage an immediate direct benefit to 500 or more from the local area.

#### 10(b) Are there any restrictions on who will benefit from the funding?

There are no restrictions. We obviously have to have certain membership categories to comply with safeguarding and insurance on the premises but we encourage anyone in the community from any age to enjoy our club whether that be as player, coach, volunteer, spectator or social member.

#### 11. Your Project's Budget

We have received quotations ranging from £7,500 incl VAT to £25,000 incl VAT. We are continuing to obtain further competitive quotes for the work.

This range reflects different levels of expenditure on the refurbishment / replacement of our nets. Ideally we wish to fund a full replacement up to ECB standard but this may be beyond our financial reach for now.

#### 11(a) How much will the project/activity cost in total?

We are confident we can deliver the project within the above budgets. Any contract would be on a fixed price basis to give us comfort that funding meets the cost.

## 11(b) Tell us about other any other sources of income you have already applied for or raised so far in relation to this project

We have recently launched a crowdfunding campaign directed at members and the wider community. We have an initial target of £8,000 and have so far raised over £4,500 towards this.

We also hope to secure Sport England match funding for this which could be worth up to 50% of our target (£4,000) We are in the process of applying for other grants including the MAG Community Fund (£3,000) and Equilibrium Community Fund (£500). We await feedback on each of these.
