Part II Resident Permit Holders Only on First Team Match days or 1st Team Rugby Match, 1<sup>st</sup> August to 31<sup>st</sup> May, noon – 5.30pm or 5.30pm – 10pm (Match Day Event Parking Zone 4): Bergara Close

From the intersection of the southern kerb line of Mercian Way on both sides to its southern extents including the western arm and southern extents. (its full Adopted

## **Booth Street / Bergara Close TRO / Parking**

Report of the Corporate Director for Place Management & Regeneration

### 1. INTRODUCTION AND PURPOSE OF REPORT

- To approve No Waiting at Any Time restrictions on Bergara Close turning head of the close.
- The approve Bergara Close be incorporated into the Parking Zone -Match Day Event Zone, Edgeley Park.

## 2. BACKGROUND

Members will be aware that planning permission has been granted for the redevelopment of the former site into residential dwellings.

The proposed restriction will help to aid turning manoeuvres and road safety at the turning head of Bergara Close. The head of the close has been designed so that drivers can perform a safe turn-around manoeuvre and obviously parked vehicles in this area will hinder such movements — especially for larger vehicles.

The current extent of the existing double yellow lines on the junction of Bergara Close is deemed necessary to reduce conflict and congestion amid traffic turning in / out of the junction with Mercian Way at the same time.

In order to consolidate traffic management in readiness for the completion of the development, it is recommended that No Waiting at Any Time restrictions (double yellow lines) be provided at the following location:

At the turning head of Bergara Close.

It is also recommended that the whole of Bergara Close is incorporated into the Parking Zone – Match Day Event Zone, Edgeley Park to control parking in this area.

### 3. PROPOSALS

The proposal for No Waiting at Any Time restrictions (double yellow lines) is delineated on attached drawing number: **D4256-000-00** 

### 4. LEGAL POSITION/IMPLICATIONS

The Traffic Management Orders would be made under Section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984. The Council is required by the Local Authorities Traffic Order (Procedure) (England and Wales) Regulations 1996 to give notice of its intention to make a Traffic Order (by publishing a draft traffic order). These regulations also require the Council to consider any representations received as a result of publishing the draft Order.

### 5. CONSULTATION

As and when the Traffic Regulation Order is advertised by Legal Services, local properties and premises will be notified and will have opportunity to register a formal objection during the adverting period.

### 6. FUNDING

Funding has been secured from the Developer for the associated legal / lining works as part of the planning conditions (Section 38 Agreement).

### 7. TIMESCALES

If approved the order is expected to become operative in 2021.
