## **Conservative Group Proposal 2021**

The Conservative Group propose that the Chairs and Vice Chairs of Scrutiny are shared between the two largest opposition parties to ensure that a wider spectrum of opposition opinion is reflected and heard.

The Conservative Group propose that for the Civic Year 21/22 the sharing of Scrutiny Chairs is allocated on a 3:2 basis reflecting that the Liberal Democrat opposition group is the larger Group but also taking into consideration the wider interests of the Borough where the vote share is closer than reflected by current composition.

The Liberal Democrat Group to Chair those Scrutiny Committees with statutory based responsibilities; Communities and Housing, Adult Social Care and Health and Children and Families. The Conservative Group to Chair Economy & Regeneration Committee and CRMG Committee.

Where the Liberal Democrat Group hold the Chair of a Scrutiny Committee, the Conservative Group will hold the Vice-Chair. Where the Conservative Group hold the Chair of a Scrutiny Committee, the Liberal Democrat Group will hold the Vice – Chair.

With regard to Ordinary Committees, the Conservative Group propose that the Chair of PHRC remains with the ruling Group. In the interests of continuity we propose that the Chair of LEAS remains with the Conservative Group so that work which is already underway on the Review of Licensing Standards is able to be completed to satisfactory timescales.

We further propose that for similar reasons, the Vice Chair of Planning stays with the Conservative Group and the Vice Chair of LEAS stays with the ruling Group.

All other Ordinary Committees Chairs and Vice-Chairs to remain as currently allocated between the ruling group, main opposition group and second opposition group.

These proposals are put forward for agreement in principal now, with nominations of named Councillors to fill each role be put forward in due course.
