9. Please give us a brief description of your proposed/planned project or activity

The first project involves us giving two disused, under-loved fields a new life; creating a community orchard, wildflower borders, new plants, community dog waste bag dispenser, an information board detailing the history of the site, including Broadstone Hall. Activities completed by Love Heaton Chapel members and resident volunteers on community planting days, school children will be involved in spring time with wildlife and planting projects (already supported and approved by the head teacher).

The second project relates to the purchase, installation and removal of an 18ft Nordmann fir Christmas tree and lights at the junction of Abney Road and School Lane, Heaton Chapel, including associated grounds maintenance for Christmas 2020. Extra costs were invoiced, for which we are requesting funding support.

10. Who will benefit from this grant?

e.g. local residents, young people, older people and how?

Good foot traffic between Heaton Chapel and South Reddish residents; particularly children moving between the two for school, children and parents attending Broadstone Primary School, which is next to the two fields, and dog walkers. The field is underused by nearby residents as it is essentially abandoned and uninviting in its current state. They will benefit because the community orchard will create a more inviting place to visit, exercise, relax, play, walk dogs, picnic, learn and plant – all great for mental and physical health.

Other beneficiaries will be employees, visitors and shoppers to the area; people passing through the area.

10(a) How Many Stockport residents will benefit?

Hundreds, as indicated above.

In relation to the Christmas tree beneficiaries, there are c. 20,000 residents in Heatons North and Reddish South, the two wards at the junction of which the tree was situated.

10(b) Are there any restrictions on who will benefit from the funding?

Fields – No

Christmas tree: Those who did not visit the area will not have seen the tree.

£474 – wooden lectern information board (showing history of Broadstone Hall), supplied by local

firm

£5 – postcrete for lectern to hold in ground

£221 – wildflower seeds for wildflower borders, misc bulbs for planting, misc plants

Tree and lights: £2757.80
