Summary:

The Neighbourhoods Service has received an application from Morleys Funfair to hold a Funfair in Torkington Park over 2 weekends in July. From $1^{st} - 4^{th}$ July and $9^{th} - 11^{th}$ July. The Funfair would set up on site from Monday 28^{th} June and would leave the site on Monday 12^{th} July.

This Funfair event has been held in Torkington Park in July for many years, usually over one weekend, with rides then being available for the Carnival the following week. Unfortunately this year the Carnival is not taking place and so the Funfair would like to open on 2 consecutive weekends.

The organiser has submitted a risk assessment with Covid Precautions, which includes regular cleaning down of rides, hand sanitizers available for customers, a sanitised token system for payment, seating on rides to be arranged with social distancing (facilitating family bubbles), and management of queues for social distancing with signage and barriers as necessary.

The Pandemic Response Team have had sight of the risk assessment and have approved the measures proposed.

As usual the public liability and ride safety certificates will be checked prior to the event going ahead.

- The event has been run at Torkington Park successfully for a number of years.
