New Horizons is a canal boat and was commissioned in 1981 by H.R.H. the Prince of Wales. It is operated by a registered charity, Stockport Canal Boat Trust for Disabled People, created by the then Mayor of Stockport the late L. Gordon Bayley M.B.E. whose charity appeal raised the money to build this specially designed boat. New Horizons offers Day, Half Day and Evening trips from April to October and is a key part of many local events in the Marple area. Operating a canal boat is not just time consuming, it's expensive and the Trust is heavily reliant on funds raised through donations and by volunteers to maintain its operation. Unscheduled emergencies like the loss of the propeller cause a significant strain on resources. The Trust is financially independent. It depends entirely on donations, bequests and sponsorship from individuals, businesses and charitable organisations to meet its operating cost. The pandemic meant that the 2020 cruising season was seriously constrained with non of our usual fundraising opportunities. On reopening for the 2021 season we have discovered that it also means, that our fundraising equipment which was stored throughout the pandemic, has suffered deterioration to the point of becoming unusable therefore restricting our recovery to funding sustainability.

Please give us a brief description of your proposed/planned project or activity To replace the Canvas Cover, back, front and sides of the 3m x 3m Tent which we use for fundraising events both in Marple and in the Local Area. This tent which we have had for 10 years, was not required during the 2020 season and when it was brought out and opened up in May 2021 it was found to have suffered significant mould and fabric damage meaning that it is no longer useable. The application is to fund replacements in a fabric which is more resistant to mould damage stronger and more suited to our storage facility and the weather in Marple.

Marple residents will benefit from the 40th year celebrations, users of the boat and the wharf will benefit from an enhanced environment.

10(a) How Many Stockport residents will benefit?

In a normal season we carry 2000 passengers.

In 2020 although severely restricted we continued to operate and had 84% occupancy on available trips.

The funding will benefit both users of the boat, volunteers and the wider community.
