<u>Highways Maintenance Local Initiative Report – Improving Security at Werneth School</u>

Report of the Corporate Director for Place Management & Regeneration

1.0 PURPOSE OF REPORT

1.1 To provide the Area Committee with details of a proposed highway maintenance scheme at Werneth School

2.0 BACKGROUND

- 2.1 Ward councillors have been made aware that a section of unsecure land at Werneth School is attracting anti-social behaviour. The school is keen to make the land secure to prevent future such issues arising and has obtained quotes for the provision of either prison mesh or palisade fencing of between 265m and 305m in length.
- 2.2 The provision of a mound in high risk areas to prohibit access to the site has been included within the scope of the works.
- 2.3 The initial estimates for the scheme are between £18,285.20 and £27,320.60 depending on the length and type of fencing implemented, however it is expected that Werneth School will raise funds and obtain grant monies from other sources to contribute to this amount.
- 2.4 The Area Committee is being requested to make a contribution of up to £5,000 towards the scheme.

3.0 PROPOSED WORK

3.1 The following would be partially funded by this Area Committee's Highway Maintenance and Traffic Management delegated budget:-

Bredbury Green & Romiley Ward

The provision of either prison mesh or palisade fencing of between 265m and 305m in length and the provision of a mound in high risk areas to prohibit access to the site at a cost of £5,000.00
