The funding is for First Aid Training. The session is for Basic Life Support, which lasts for a couple of hours and covers:

- Safe management of an incident
- Dealing with an unresponsive breathing casualty (recovery position)
- Dealing with an unresponsive non-breathing casualty (CPR & Chain of survival)
- Dealing with a choking casualty both mild and severe (back slaps & abdominal thrusts)
- Using an Automated External Defibrillator

The number of attendees is limited only by how many people can access the equipment (e.g. dummy) during the session
