**Report of the Corporate Director for Place Management & Regeneration**

**1. INTRODUCTION AND PURPOSE OF REPORT**

- 1.1 To seek approval for the installation of bollards on the footway at the Smithy Green, High Lane junction, Woodley.

**2. BACKGROUND**

- 2.1. Traffic Services have received a request from the Bredbury & Woodley councillors to install 2 No bollards on the footway at the Smithy Green, High Lane junction as vehicles are said to be using the footway to pass parked cars.
- 2.2. An estimated cost was provided and the Highway Ward Spokesperson has requested that a report be prepared for the Area Committee to consider the proposal to install bollards as shown on the attached drawing **NM1**.

**3. PROPOSALS**

- 3.1. In order to prevent vehicles from mounting the footway at the Smithy Green, High Lane junction it is proposed to install a total of 2 bollards as shown on NM1 - Smithy Green, Woodley - 2 Middleton Bollards

**4. CONSIDERATION OF ALTERNATIVE SOLUTIONS**
