Report of the Corporate Director for Place Management & Regeneration

1. INTRODUCTION AND PURPOSE OF REPORT

To approve measures to expand coverage of existing 20mph speed limit repeater signage and road markings on Canterbury Road and surrounding streets in Offerton.

2. BACKGROUND

Network Management received representation from the Ward Councillors (Manor) acting on behalf of residents in the area of Canterbury Road between Hall Street and Turncroft Lane. It is reported that many drivers are not respecting the existing 20mph speed limit and the Councillors have requested measures to improve the speed limit signage; with a particular emphasis on Canterbury Road and Glebe Street which provide a straight corridor between Hall Street and Turncroft Lane.

3. PROPOSALS

In order to improve the 20mph speed limit signage, it is proposed to introduce 20mph roundel carriageway markings and additional repeater signs at the locations indicated on the attached drawing number: **NM18-6359**.

The associated cost for the attached measures will be **£1,300.00** funded from the delegated Ward Budget. Note: The immediate households will be notified before any lining work is carried-out on site.

4. TIMESCALES

If approved the lining and signing works can be expected on site in Jan / Feb 2022.
