LEDER ACTION PLAN UPDATE

Report of the Chair of the LeDeR Governance Group

1. INTRODUCTION AND PURPOSE OF REPORT

Learning from Deaths Reviews (LeDeR reviews) are now a core part of the quality of care oversight across Stockport when we monitor the care that has been provided to people with a learning disability. The monitoring of the LeDeR Action Plan is managed through the LeDeR governance group chaired by the CCG Executive Nurse. This report is distilled from the very detailed action plan and is provided to describe the themes, and the improvement work being undertaken to fulfil the requirements of LeDeR Action Plan for 2020-2022. LeDeR improvement processes like all other work streams have been impacted by the COVID 19 pandemic. The recovery of progress is now underway.

2. CONCLUSIONS AND RECOMMENDATIONS

- (1) Note the recovery position of the Action plan, and the continuance of the oversight by the Leder Governance Group.
