Report of the Corporate Director for Place Management & Regeneration

1. INTRODUCTION AND PURPOSE OF REPORT

To approve the revocation of a mandatory disabled bay on Claremont Road in Great Moor.

2. BACKGROUND

Network Management received notification that the disabled bay facility (Blue Badge Holders Only) fronting No. 41 Claremont Road is now redundant as the original applicant no longer resides at the address. Note: Presumably a mandatory bay was originally deemed necessary due to the close proximity to a school.



In agreement with the Ward Councillors the immediate properties were notified about the situation and no opposition was forthcoming about revoking the facility.

3. LEGAL POSITION/IMPLICATIONS

The Traffic Management Orders would be made under Section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984. The Council is required by the Local Authorities Traffic Order (Procedure) (England and Wales) Regulations 1996 to give notice of its intention to make a Traffic Order (by publishing a draft traffic order). These regulations also require the Council to consider any representations received as a result of publishing the draft Order.

4. FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS

In order to reduce the legal costs, the revocation order can be co-advertised with another traffic order funded from the Ward Budget.
