| Chelmsford/ Chatham Street | Traffic Regulation Orders No Waiting At Any Time junction protection Consultation with residents/ businesses completed December 2021. Consultation results to be analysed. |
| Sandown Road/ Stockport Road | Traffic Regulation Order No Waiting At Any Time at Stockport Road junction with Sandown Road Report to be considered by the Area Committee on 27 January 2022 where Members are requested to recommend that the Cabinet Member for Sustainable Stockport approves the cost of works (measures to install a build out of the footway/ install bollards at the junction of Stockport Road and Sandown Road to prevent parking and aid visibility). |
| Edgeley Road | To extend bus stop marking and remove hatched area to the bottom outside the Railway Club Report to be considered by the Area Committee on 27 January 2022 where Members are asked to recommend that the Cabinet Member for Sustainable Stockport approve the cost for the lining works. |
| Toronto Road | Proposed Waiting Restrictions Traffic Regulation Order advertised, but objections received. Report to be submitted to a future meeting of the Aarea committee. |
| Mercian Way/ Bergara Close | Traffic Regulation Order for new housing development and resident parking zone Approved at the meeting of the meeting of the Area Committee in April 2021 and Traffic Regulation Order advertised in August 2021. Traffic Services to send out permit letters to residents. Traffic Regulation Order to be implemented as part of development. Signs on site awaiting surfacing of carriageway by developer. |
| Charles Street | Proposed Waiting Restrictions Traffic Regulation Order (TRO) advertised 21 September 2020. Objection received and an anomaly was identified |

| Hempshaw Lane – Battersby Hat Works Site | Traffic Regulation Order as part of the redevelopment Report approved March 2020. Traffic Regulation Order advertised with no objections. Lining works on hold (including revocations) until notification from Highway Design as site access needed for large wagons etc. |
| Heaviley Grove | Parking issues on private road and car park Reviewed on site on more than three occasions. Reviewed on different days and different times. Images taken on site. Potential to install bollards. |
| Firwood Close | Parking and viability issues on Firwood Close due to Health Centre Car Park Consultation completed. |
| Brinnington Estate | General speeding issues around the whole of the estate Reviewed areas where there is perceived speeding and which areas are currently a 20mph zone within the area. On site review undertaken. Consider area for future active neighbourhood scheme. |
| Kimberley Street | Specific automated traffic counter requested for this road due to speeding issues Cobbled street so not possible to install automated traffic counter without damage to surfacing. Radar survey ordered January 2022. |
| Forbes Road and Forbes Close | Parking restrictions at the junction Traffic Regulation Order to become operative December 2021. |
| East Street | Proposed Waiting Restrictions Report to be considered by the Area Committee on 27 January 2022 where Members are asked to approve the statutory legal advertising of the Traffic Regulation Order (detailed in the report and, subject to no objections being received within twenty one days from the advertisement date, the Order can be made). Details of consultation findings contained within the report. |
